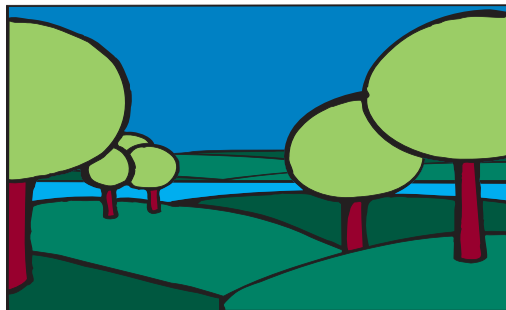

The Celebration Tree Grove

The **Celebration Tree Grove**, located at the northeast edge of White Rock Lake Park, is the result of three powerful forces meeting in one peaceful place.

- **Devoted citizens** came with a mission to Honor, Remember, and Celebrate friends and loved ones by planting trees at White Rock Lake.
- **The City of Dallas Park and Recreation Department** came with a mission to support ongoing stewardship of existing and future trees at White Rock Lake.
- **And For the Love of the Lake** came with a mission to preserve and enhance White Rock Lake Park with a natural sanctuary dedicated to the people of Dallas and devoted to the reforestation of our Urban Oasis.

The Founders Plaque



What: The Celebration Tree Grove is a place where people can Honor, Remember, and Celebrate loved ones by contributing to ongoing reforestation efforts at White Rock Lake Park, beginning with the Tree Grove.

The Grove provides new, mature trees surrounding the core of the network of pathways. Beneath a canopy of trees, small stone structures host bronze plaques, honoring Lake Lovers past, present, and future. Butterflies flutter by in the garden, and benches offer a peaceful place to enjoy the tranquility of the Grove.

Once the Grove is fully established, funds raised through donations will go toward reforestation and tree maintenance throughout the entire park.

Where: The Celebration Tree Grove is on the east side of White Rock Lake Park, on East Lawther, between Poppy Drive and Lake Highlands Drive. Enter the park at the light at Buckner and Poppy. At the stop sign, it's on your right.
